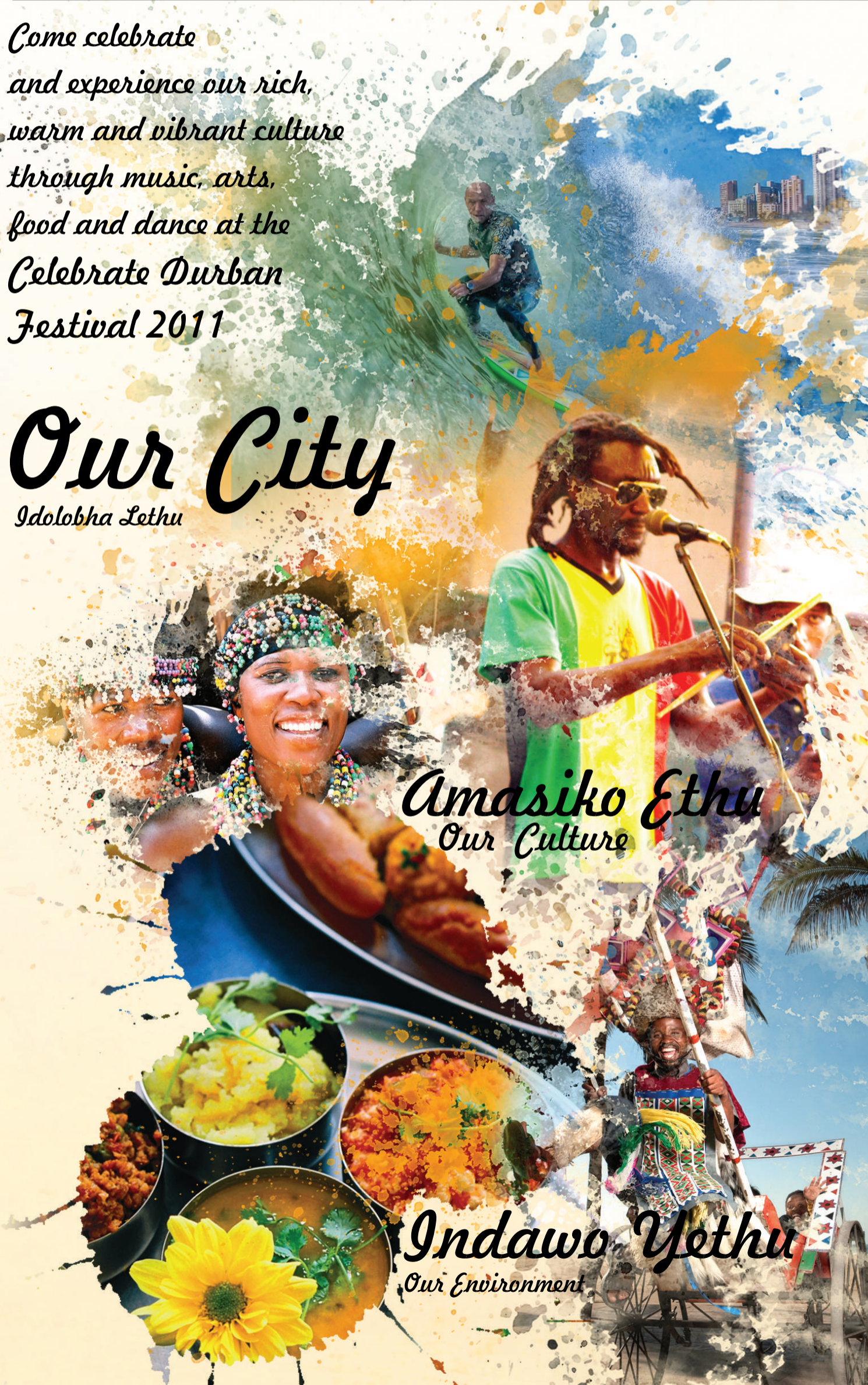

The festival includes various categories of music, community cultural festivals, extensive sports programmes and other various events to promote and celebrate our culture diversity and heritage.



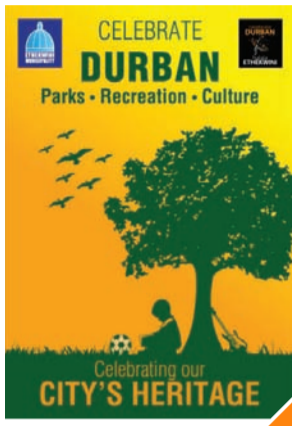
