patterns, the best of Durban's Deco creations can be seen at Surrey Mansions (323 Currie Road), Manhattan Court (Broad Street) and Hollywood Court (Anton Lembede – formerly Smith – Street). The city actively promotes this rich heritage through the Durban Art Deco Society (031 301 1951) or (**www.durbandeco.org.za**), which may be contacted for tours and other information. With its impressive “arch of triumph” the functional **MOSES MABIDA STADIUM** is a defining landmark similar to Sydney's Opera House or The London Eye. The site of the trilling encounter between Germany and Spain in the 2010 World Cup semi-finals, the stadium is a tourist attraction in its own right as well as being the centre-piece of the King's Park Sporting Precinct, which supports a wide range of sporting, commercial, cultural, retail and leisure activities. Guided professional, general and school tours are offered (031 582 8242).



RIKSHA BUS CITY TOURS (Richard 031 322 4188) operate seven days a week and offer both tourist and the locals a chance to soak up the sights of Durban. Tours take place from 09:00 to 12:00 and 13:00 to 16:00 every day, leaving from the Municipal Police Station in Borscombe Terrace. Tickets are available at Tourist Junction as well as the Ricksha Bus office in Borscombe Terrace.

Enjoy a bird's eye view of Durban from the air with a **HELICOPTER FLIP**. JNC Helicopters (031 563 9513), uShaka Helicopter Tours (031 328 8000), Virginia Airport (031 563 7101) or Air Safaris (084 257 0835).

Qualified environmental education site guides lead **NATURE WALKS** (031 311 6717) at nature reserves in and around Durban such as Burman Bush, Paradise Valley, Pigeon Valley and Silverglen. Or take a guided walk around the Durban Botanical Gardens (031 309 1170).

A **BOAT CRUISE** around the bay takes you past interesting sights such as the impressive Sugar Terminal, Bayhead Heritage Park, colourful yacht marina, dry and floating docks and the coming and goings of tugs, ships and cruise liners. Explore another side of Durban's fascinating history on a **WHALING HISTORY TOUR** of the old whaling station on the Bluff Headlands. Tours take in one of the largest private collections of pictures, memorabilia, newspaper clippings and old footage of the Durban whaling operation, and visit the old whaling factory station in the company of past employees. Tuesdays and Thursdays (082 336 7433 or 031 467 9461).

Flanking Durban's harbour, the **BLUFF HEADLAND** has a colourful history dominated by navigational and military use over the past 150 years, and has been the site of numerous shipwrecks as well as both quarantine and whaling stations, with ancient iron works discovered here dating back some 1600 years back. Bluff Headland Heritage Park (031 304 4934)

Take a **RIKSHA RIDE** along the beachfront in one of these rainbow-coloured, two-seaters, pulled by a man in a beaded costume with massive horned headdress. (Sipho 083 626 8876 or 031 331 4497)

Visitors are welcome to tour the majestic gold-domed **JUMMAH MUSJID MOSQUE** (031 306 0026) on the corner of Dr Yusuf Dadoo (Grey) and Dennis Hurley (Queen) streets. Dating to the 1880's, it holds about

6 000 worshippers and lays claim to being the largest place of worship for Muslims in the southern hemisphere. The dress code requires men to wear long trousers and women long skirts or pants.

Built in Gothic revival style, the **EMMANUEL CATHOLIC CATHEDRAL** (031 306 3595) in Durban's city centre is known as much for its role in the struggle against apartheid as for its imposing architecture, with the cathedral having been the centre of intense political activity in the mid 1980's.

An opulently decorated architectural masterpiece, the **HARE KRISHNA TEMPLE OF UNDERSTANDING** (031 403 3328) in Chatsworth is designed in the shape of a lotus flower. Guided tours are given of the ornate marble temple room and inner sanctuary, along with an audio-visual show. There is an excellent vegetarian restaurant.

Discover a different side of African urban culture on a **TOWNSHIP TOURS** with a local guide and visit a vibrant and colourful shebeen where locals come together to enjoy good music and food in a lively atmosphere. Contact Thuthuka Tours (082 264 2556) or Isivivane Tourism for tours of Claremont (031 707 5665 or 072 665 1731).

The **INANDA TRAIL** (031 519 0334) is rich in both African and Indian culture as well as the struggle for peace and democracy, with ties to both the birth of Mahatma Gandhi's philosophy of non-violent resistance and the African National Congress. Visit Gandhi's Phoenix Settlement, as well as the villages of Ekuphakameni and Ebuhleni, the headquarters of the Nazareth Baptist Church founded by Isaiah Shembe. Another top attraction is Ohlange, the school founded by John L Dube, who was the first president of the ANC, while the nearby Inanda Seminary founded in 1869 was South Africa's first high school for African girls.

The **PHOENIX SETTLEMENT** is a South African heritage site, and Gandhi's home contains the printing press on which the country's first Indian newspaper was printed as well as a collection of photographs of Gandhi in SA and India. A clinic and HIV/AIDS Centre have been established here as well as a preschool and primary school to serve the surrounding community. Contact Mr Kalideen (031 262 6692 or 083 787 6789).

Head west, where the breathtaking scenery of the **VALLEY OF 1000 HILLS** tourism route (031 777 1874) is the setting of many an adventure activity. There are also unique arts and crafts, fine restaurants, pubs and country hotels, with highlights including the magnificent Krantzklouf Gorge, Zulu culture villages, a children's animal farms, game viewing, hiking, mountain climbing and horse trails. Take a trip back in time on the 1000 Hills Choo-Choo (082 353 6003), a vintage steam-train that runs along the old main line between 1877 and 1880.

This beautifully situated **MARIANNHILL MONASTERY** near Pinetown was established in 1882 as a Catholic Mission. In addition to its legacy of resistance against apartheid, the monastery has a school which educated many leaders of the struggle. Today the Jabulani Self-Help Centre here helps in developing the surroundings community while an art gallery displays the work of local artists. Famed for its fresh organic produce, including milk, cheese and yogurt, the monastery also has an outdoor tea garden serving delicious meals in the most restful settings. (031 700 2704/4288)

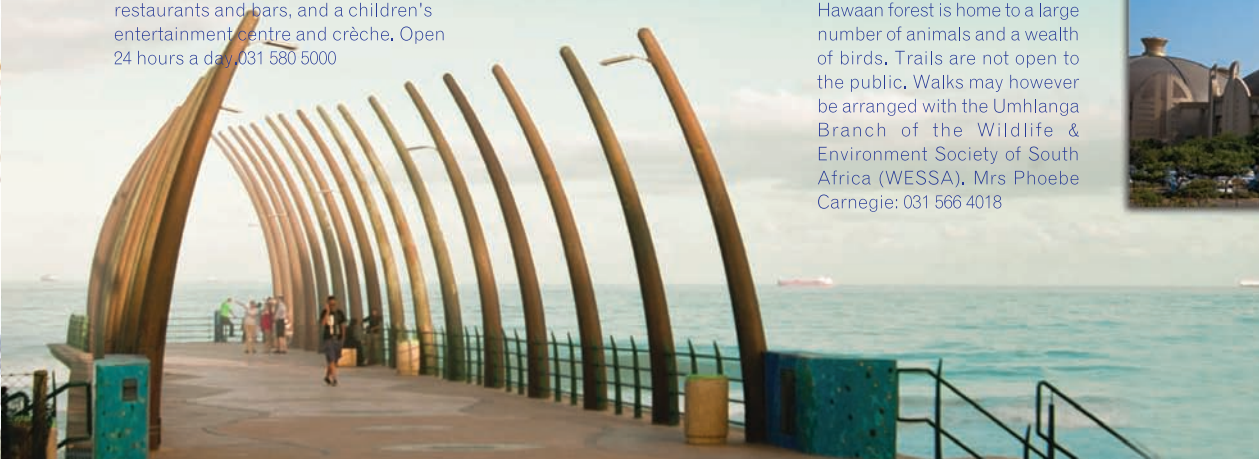

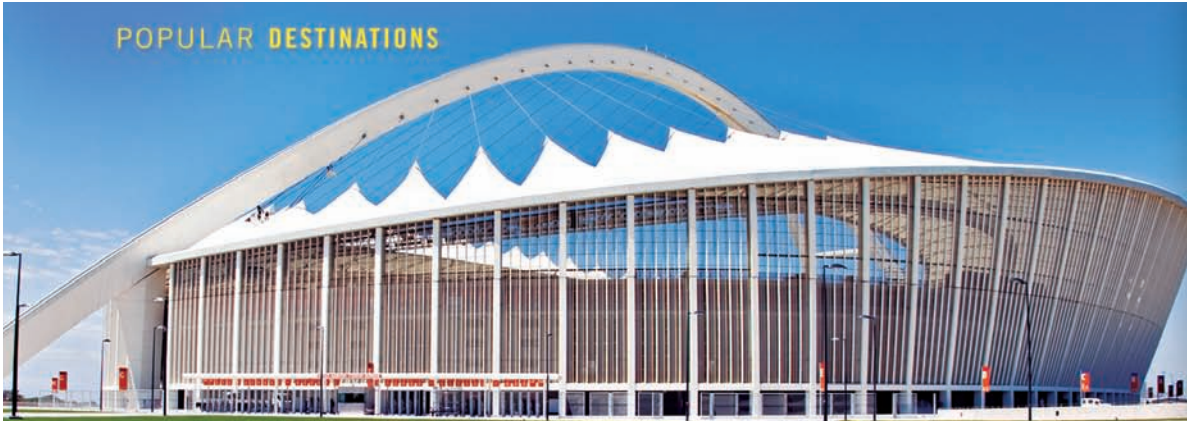
